



BUILDING BLOCKS TO SOCIAL SKILLS

Goals/Purpose:

- To help children with ASD, aged 6–8, improve their social interactions at home, with friends and family, at school, and in the community.

Program Outline:

- The 8-week program will focus on improving the child's social skills, teach them new skills and ways of interacting with others.
- Topics covered include:
 - Stages of Social and Emotional Development
 - Communication (Verbal and Nonverbal)
 - Emotions and Emotional Regulation
 - Paying Attention to OthersShared Interaction

Program Features:

- Small Group Sizes (Maximum of 5)
- Parents will be taught how to facilitate their child's social interactions
- Written Evaluation of Progress at the end of the Program
- Interactive teaching with both the parent and child about play and social skills.
- Improve the parent-child relationship through real-life, natural interactions and activities
